REGULATIONS

1. NO MOVEMENT ON SATURDAY, SUNDAY, OR HOLIDAYS.
2. MOVEMENT SHALL BE DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS (SUNRISE TO SUNSET).
3. PERMIT GRANTED FOR USE ON COUNTY ROADS ONLY, AUTHORIZATION FOR ANY OTHER ROADS MUST BE OBTAINED FROM THE APPROPRIATE AUTHORITIES UNDER WHOSE JURISDICTION THEY BELONG.
4. NO SIGNS, GUARDRAIL, OR OTHER COUNTY PROPERTY SHALL BE REMOVED OR DISTURBED.
5. NO MOVEMENT ALLOWED ON ROADS EXCEEDING POSTED LIMITATIONS DURING SEASONAL ROAD RESTRICTIONS OR ANY OTHER TIME.
6. MOVEMENT SHALL NOT BE STARTED IF VISIBILITY IS POOR OR HIGHWAY CONDITIONS ARE HAZARDOUS OR SLIPPERY. IF MOVEMENT HAS BEEN STARTED, AND ADVERSE CONDITIONS, SUCH AS FOG, HEAVY RAIN, SNOW, ICE, HIGH WINDS, OR OTHER HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS DEVELOP, MOVEMENT MUST BE STOPPED UNTIL CONDITIONS PERMIT TO CONTINUE.
7. IN THE EVENT OF A BREAKDOWN, VEHICLES & EQUIPMENT SHALL BE MOVED OFF THE ROAD RIGHT OF WAY, IF IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO DO SO IMMEDIATELY PUT UP THE PROPER FLAGS AND REFLECTORS. REFLECTORS AND FLARES SHOULD BE STATIONED TO PROTECT AND WARN TRAFFIC AT ALL TIMES.
8. IN THE EVENT EQUIPMENT HAS TO REMAIN ON THE RIGHT OF WAY OVERNIGHT, THE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPT. SHOULD BE NOTIFIED IMMEDIATELY.
9. TRAFFIC TO BE PROTECTED AT ALL TIMES WITH PROPER ESCORTS AND TRAVEL DELAYED ONLY MOMENTARILY.
10. RED OR ORANGE FLAGS TO BE PLACED ON STRUCTURE AT ALL EXTREMITIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH HIGHWAY REGULATIONS.
11. LOADS ON BRIDGES EXCEEDING LEGAL OR POSTED LIMITATIONS ARE NOT ALLOWED UNLESS ANALYSIS INDICATED MOVEMENT CAN BE MADE WITHOUT DAMAGE TO STRUCTURES.
12. MUST HAVE ADEQUATE BRAKES CONTROLLED FROM THE CAB OF TOWING VEHICLE.
13. THE PERMITEE IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL LIABILITY FOR PERSONAL INJURY, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR TIME LOST, WHICH MAY OCCUR IN RELATION TO THE MOVEMENT AND IN THE EVENT ANY CLAIM IS MADE AGAINST THE COUNTY OF TODD OR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT OR ANY EMPLOYEE THEREOF THROUGH BY REASON OF OR IN ANY CONNECTION WITH ANY ACT OR OMISSION: PERMITEE SHALL DEFEND INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS FROM ANY CLAIM.
14. IN ACCEPTING THIS PERMIT, THE PERMITEE AGREES TO REPAIR ANY EXPENSE TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR, AND ANY DAMAGE TO THE HIGHWAY STRUCTURES. WORK OF REPAIR MAY BE DONE BY COUNTY PUBLIC WORK FORCES AT THE OPTION OF THE SAID DEPARTMENT AND THE COST OF SUCH WORK TO BE DONE BY THE PERMITEE.
