On March 24, 2024, the Todd County Sheriff's Office responded to a two vehicle crash on County Road 19, south of Ward Springs. A 2004 Mercury Sable being driven by Thomas Bardson of Sauk Centre was traveling north on County 19, when he lost control of his vehicle. Bardson's vehicle collided with a vehicle traveling south on County 19, driven by Haley Ramacher of Freeport. Road conditions are believed to be a contributing factor.
