

Adult Mental Health Case Management Services: services include a functional assessment, individual community support plan, referral and assistance in getting needed mental health and other services, coordination of services and monitoring of the delivery of services.

Examples of Adult Mental Health Case Management Activities include but are not limited to the following:

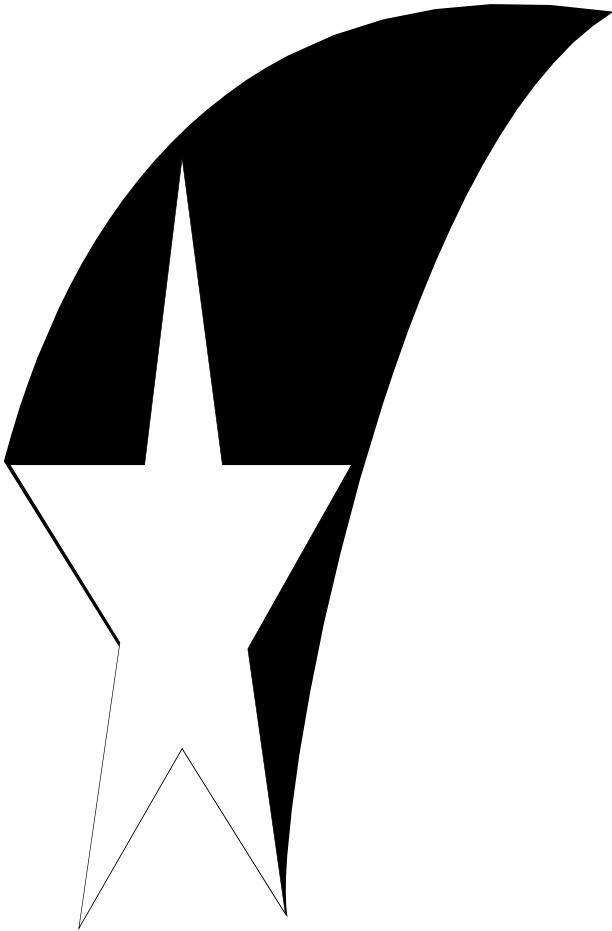
- ◆ Assisting a client in obtaining needed services
- ◆ Coordinating with other agencies to obtain services for clients
- ◆ Completion and regular review of a written functional assessment
- ◆ The development and regular review of a written individual community support plan for a client based on both a functional and a diagnostic assessment of the client and incorporating the individual treatment plans
- ◆ Participating in case conferences, administrative reviews, client staffing and informal conferences
- ◆ Development of goals, service plans, written service agreement and routine case supervisory activities
- ◆ Routine contacts and other monitoring or communication with the client, family members or relevant persons with consent

from the client regarding the status of the client, the individual service plan or progress in achieving the goals of the service plan

- ◆ Receipt of clinical supervision regarding an identified client with serious and persistent mental illness
- ◆ All planning, assessments, record keeping and documentation associated with the service coordination of a case
- ◆ Assessing and evaluating the effectiveness of services received by a client
- ◆ Arranging for transportation needed for a client to access services
- ◆ Assisting the client in obtaining third party payment for covered medical services
- ◆ Assisting the client in obtaining any other eligible benefits that may be needed (i.e. fuel assistance, social security disability, food support, etc.)
- ◆ Monitoring the discharge planning process for a client being discharged from a residential treatment facility, regional treatment center, or inpatient hospital

Adult Mental Health Case Management is **NOT**:

- ◆ Treatment or therapy
- ◆ Case Management provided under a WAIVER (CAC, CADI, BI, DD)
- ◆ Legal advocacy
- ◆ Performing a diagnostic assessment
- ◆ Administration and management of a client's medications
