Motion approved. **Motion** made by Vic Carlson seconded by Dave Fragodt to approve the payment of claims #3906- #3915. Motion carried.

**Correspondence:**

Township map was looked at and sent back to the state with no changes to it.

Noxious weed letter was read and signed by the supervisors.

We received our settlement payment of \$31,258.97.

**Reports:**

- Cemetery Update- Dave reported that nothing has changed since the last meeting.
