Plan Maintenance

A. Relationship to the County Community-Based Comprehensive Plan

The Todd County Community Based Comprehensive Plan adopted by the County Board of Commissioners on March 6, 2001, included a series of recommendations on future parks and trail projects in the County.

With the adoption of this Plan by the Board of Commissioners, it is intended that this document replace the park and recreation provisions adopted in the 2001 Comprehensive Plan. Upon adoption by the County Board of Commissioners, this Plan would replace the goals, objectives and action items for Parks and Recreation found in Volume 2 on page 253 and Parks and Recreation System Plan on pages 323 to 330 of the Comprehensive Plan.

B. Plan Review, Updates and Amendments

Over the next ten to twenty years, the County anticipates that there will be changes in the social, economic, and environmental conditions. These changes may require updates or amendments to this Plan. Therefore, the County Board will need to maintain the Plan over time. Recommendations for the maintenance of this Plan include the following:

1. Annual Review and Report. The Parks and Recreation Board (PRB) shall review the Plan on an annual basis and provide a report to the County Board each year on progress made. The PRB should report its findings to the County Board by January 31 of each year.
2. Plan Updates. The PRB should initiate and complete a major update of the Plan within ten years.
3. Plan Amendments. All requests to amend the Parks, Open Space and Trails Plan should be reviewed by the PRB and the Planning Commission. Plan amendments should not become County policy until the change has been adopted by the County Board. A public hearing by the Planning Commission will be required for all amendments to the Plan.

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
