Tribal Sanitizer Grant		Robert Keenan		rbrtkeenan@gmail.com	<p>We would like to apply for FEMA DHS Tribal grant money (EMPG-S – Region V DHS-20-GPD-042-05-02; see attached NOFO) allocated in response to Covid-19 to produce hand and surface sanitizer that will be distributed to tribal members and healthcare facilities to mitigate the spread of Covid-19 (as well as Tuberculosis) in Minnesota's tribal communities. Our hand and surface sanitizer will be made using the W.H.O. recommended recipe for such sanitizers. Because we will be using ethanol in our recipe, our project will also help the currently financially strapped ethanol production community. Tribal members will be involved in the production of our products.</p> <p>In order to apply for this money, we must apply through the State of Minnesota Administrative or Emergency Management Agencies. The total amount of money available is \$1,769,795 (plus indirect costs to the State) for this two year grant. Only one application per State will be accepted.
