This permit is authorized per Minnesota Statute 169 (Traffic Regulations) and all applicants must comply with its requirements.

Todd County Oversized and Overweight Load Permit Special Provisions

1. This permit is not valid on Saturday, Sunday, Holidays or after dark (defined as sunrise to sunset of that day) unless approved at the sole description of the County Engineer.
2. This permit must be carried in the vehicle and be made available for inspection upon request.
3. This permit is granted for use on Todd County roads only; authorization for any other road must be obtained from the appropriate authorities under whose jurisdiction they belong.
4. No traffic signs, guardrail, or other County owned property shall be removed or disturbed.
5. No movement allowed that exceeds posted load limits during regular or seasonal road restrictions.
6. No loads on bridges exceeding the legal or posted limitations are allowed unless a structural analysis is provided indicating the movement can be made without damage to the bridge. The analysis shall be conducted by a professional engineer selected by the County at the sole expense of the applicant.
7. No movement shall be started if visibility is poor or highway conditions are hazardous. If movement has been started and adverse conditions (i.e. fog, heavy rain, snow, ice, high winds) develop, movement must be stopped until conditions improve to an acceptable condition.
8. In the event of a breakdown, vehicles and equipment shall be moved off of the road right of way immediately. In the event equipment has to remain on the right of way overnight, the Todd County Sherriff's Office and Public Works Department shall be notified immediately.
9. Traffic shall be protected at all times with proper escorts and travel shall be delayed only momentarily.
10. Appropriate warning flags shall be placed on the load at all extremities in accordance with State Statutes and Regulations.
11. Load must have adequate brakes controlled from the cab of the towing vehicle.
12. The Applicant agrees to repair any damage caused to any highway or highway structure as part of this movement to the satisfaction of the County Engineer at the sole expense of the applicant. If the repair work is determined to be done by County Forces, the applicant will reimburse the County in full for all expenses of such work.
13. The Applicant agrees to be responsible for all liability for personal injury, property damage or time lost; which may occur in relation to the movement and in the event any claim is made against Todd County or any employee thereof through reason of or in any connection with act or omission. The applicant shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the County from any claim including any attorney's fees and costs related thereto to the extent permitted by Minnesota Law.
14. The Applicant must submit a copy of their current Liability Insurance Certificate that indicates that they have coverage in excess of \$100,000 (per person)/\$300,000 (per accident) for Personal Injury Liability Coverage and for \$100,000 Property Damage Coverage.
